

Grappling National Women and Men Finals 2019. September 28. Budapest, Sports Castle of Pestszentimre

INFORMATION


The Hungarian Grappling Championship has a two-stage system for the Adult age group in Gi Grappling and NoGi grappling events. This means, that the Hungarian National Finals are organized separately, where the competitors need to qualify themselves on the League rounds.

Rules of the qualification and the quota handout system

1. We announce the Hungarian Champion titles and medal places in the five Women (53 kg, 58 kg, 64 kg, 71 kg, 71+ kg) and in the eight Men (62 kg, 66 kg, 71 kg, 77 kg, 84 kg, 92 kg, 100 kg, 100+ kg) weight categories in both Gi and NoGi events.
2. The League rounds are also qualification rounds for the Hungarian National Finals. 2 competitors can get into the National Finals from every Men and Women adult advanced categories on every League Round, that means we hand out 2 quotas on every League Round. From Expert, Beginner and Open categories no one can get into the Finals.
3. Only those competitors gets quotas, who finished among the top eight in the category and did not get a qualification earlier in that category.
4. If we couldn't hand out every quotas (for example: there are less than 10 qualified competitor after the 5th Round) and there is an unqualified competitor in the top eight, then we will hand out a **third quota**.
5. The Hungarian National Finals will be organized in those categories, where at least **4 competitor is qualified** (verified with statement). If we do not organize a category, then competitors qualified in this category can compete in one higher weight category, if they are willing to.
6. In both events (Gi and NoGi) competitors can compete in only one weight category, therefore, if a competitor gets qualified in multiple weight categories, he/she have to choose one weight category in which he/she will compete. It is allowed for a competitor to be qualified for the finals in both Gi and NoGi events at once.

Organization of the Hungarian National Finals

1. The Hungarian National Finals Finals will be held on 2019. September 28. at Budapest, Sports Castle of Pestszentimre.
2. The Competitors will pay the double of the regular entry fee (one category is 10.000 HUF, two category is 17.000 HUF) and they receive an ID with their photo.
3. Associations get one free spectator ticket after every competitor they delegated, everyone else have to pay **2.000 HUF spectator admission fee**.
4. Winners in each category get the Hungarian Grappling Federation's Champion Belt. Second and third places get trophies. we hand out 2 third places as we do in the Open categories.
5. There will be 3 competition mats and 1 warm-up mat on the day of the competition.
6. **The competition will start at 10:00** with the Gi elimination rounds, then the NoGi elimination rounds. Gi registration closes at 9:45, NoGi registration closes at 11:45.

7. The bronze matches and the finals will be prioritized after the elimination rounds on 3 mats, first in the Gi and then in the NoGi event. The matches will be organized in each category in ascending order based on the weight. We organize the women categories first, then the men categories.
8. In each category, we organize the bronze matches at the same time on the left and right mats and after that, we organize the final on the center mat. Every competitor who gets to the bronze matches will get a diploma and losers of the bronze matches, who finished fifth place will stand beside the podium.
9. Matches and award ceremonies will be in turns. A category's award ceremony will take place after the next category's final. For example: the Men 71 kg award ceremony will be after the Men 77 kg final.

Competitor registration, statement and photo

1. Qualifications can be acquired only by competitors who have license. This Finals is an exception, competitors can acquire qualifications if they commit themselves, that on the day of the competition, they will have a valid license.
2. Qualification must be affirmed with the statement, until then, it is just a qualification without statement.
3. After the last League round until **August 31**, the qualified competitor need to make the statement, that he/she will take part in the National Finals according to the competition rules.
4. The competitor will make a statement, that he accepts his qualification and he will compete in the correspondent weight category and if there is less than 4 competitor in the category, he/she is willing to compete in one higher weight group.
5. Hungarian competitors state, that he/she will have valid license at the time of the competition and accepts, that he/she can't compete without the license. Foreign competitors state, that he/she will pay the 50 EUR registration fee.
6. The Competitor accepts in the statement, that he/she is obliged to send a portrait photo and a full body photo of him/herself until 2019. August 31. on the info@globalgrappling.hu e-mail address (*photos needs to be taken with a bright and plain background. In the Gi for Gi categories and in the Nogi clothing for Nogi categories.*)
7. The portrait photo is required for the ID, the full body photo will be used for the promotion of the Hungarian National Finals, where we introduce the competitors.
8. In this point we would like to draw attention on our rule, which we take very seriously on this competition: The NoGi clothing consists from **a red rashguard and a non red rashguard**. The competitor, who gets called first shall step on the mat in the red rashguard and the competitor, who gets called second shall step on the mat in the non red rashguard. There are no color restrictions on the color of the Gi and shorts. **Red and non red rashguard must be presented at weighing (registration)!**

Aggravation of rules from season 8

From Season 8, 2019. October, only that competitor can qualify to the Hungarian National Finals, who have a valid grappling license from the Hungarian Grappling Federation on the League Round. This means that the license cannot be replaced afterwards (as it is now)! However, competitors without grappling license can enter and compete on the League rounds, but they can't get ranking points and quotas.
